



## The busy day dominoes

<b>Type of game:</b>	Domino
<b>Usage in teaching foreign languages:</b>	Students learn conjugation of regular and irregular verbs in past, present and future tenses
<b>Level:</b>	From A1.1
<b>Group size:</b>	For groups up to 10 students. Whether used in 1-to-1 tuition or in groups, the teacher will always have to be present in order to correct mistakes immediately. Hence having only one group is preferable.
<b>Duration:</b>	15 to 30 minutes, depending on the students' level
<b>Contents of the game:</b>	48 Domino cards and 1 manual including further suggestions for variations of the game
<b>How does it work:</b>	Using dominoes rules, students must correctly conjugate each verb to match the illustrated side of one card to the correct written description that appears on another card.
<b>Our experiences:</b>	The game helps the students in internalising verb conjugations
<b>Our valuation:</b>	+ it is a very attractive game, both didactically and visually - the cards are pretty big, hence you need enough space to place all the cards on the table or floor
